

Brief institutional presentation

The <u>European Consumers Union (ECU)</u> is a European consumer organisation which complies with all of the <u>condition established by EU Institutions</u>. ECU is a non-governmental and non-for-profit organisation which is independent of industry, commercial and business or other conflicting interests. Its primary objective is the promotion and protection of the health, safety, economic and legal interests of European consumers. ECU is mandated to represent consumers' interests at Union level by organisations in at least half of the Member States and it is active at regional and national level. Member organisations are consumers' representative, in accordance with their national rules or practice.

Founded in 2009, ECU is composed by 22 National Consumer Associations coming from 16 EU Member States plus 1 extra Member EU as ratified in the Paris ECU General Assembly 2018.
